Department Detail- Bio-Medical Waste Unit

Safdarjang Hospital is one of the largest hospitals in Delhi having 1531 sanctioned beds, OPD patients 5-6 thousands per day (approx.), patient attending casualty is about 700 per day. The hospital is performing 170-180 operations per day, 50-70 deliveries per day, 10-15 postmortem per day.

The issues of Biomedical waste management are being looked after by the Bio Medical waste unit.

Objective – Bio-Medical Waste Management

1. Implementation of the Bio Medical Waste Mgmt. rules- 2016 under the provision of Environment Act 1986 in the hospital.
2. Monitor and ensure effective, Bio Medical Waste Mgmt. in the hospital.
3. Organize proper and timely training program for all categories of workers.
4. Establishing a system where all categories of personnel perceive responsibility as per accountability for proper waste management.
5. Adoption of environment and patient friendly norms.

COMMITTEES:

Bio Medical Waste Mgmt. Rules 2016, mandates the formation of Committees to oversee Biomedical Waste in the hospital and for implementation of these rules. There is also a Safdarjung Hospital Bio Medical Waste Mgmt. Policy.

- Bio Medical Waste Committee (To meet every 6 months in June & December)
- Environment Committee (To meet once a year)
- Bio Medical Waste Training Cell
