

**INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES OF WRITTEN EXAMINATION FOR THE POST  
OF SENIOR RESIDENT ON REGULAR BASIS.**

- All the eligible candidates should check his/her Roll Number in the list of eligible candidates with allotted roll numbers and must bring copy of the admit card (to be downloaded & printed) (as per his/her roll no.) from the hospital's website ([www.vmmc-sjh.nic.in](http://www.vmmc-sjh.nic.in)).
- Candidates to bring **Black/Blue ball point pen**.
- Textual material, printed or written, bits of papers, envelope or any other material like Calculators, Electronic Digital Watches with facilities of calculators, cellular phones, pagers, Bluetooth devices or any other electronic gadget are not allowed inside the Examination hall.
- Candidates are advised in their own interest not to bring any of the banned items including Mobile Phone to the venue of the examination as arrangement for safe keeping cannot be assured.
- Any candidate found using any unfair means or cheating will be summarily disqualified from appearing in examination.
- There will be 100 MCQ questions to be answered **in one hour**. Each question has four options, out of which only one is correct/most appropriate.
- **There will be negative marking, and one-fourth marks will be deducted for each wrong answer.**
- Fill all the details in OMR sheet carefully, like roll no., name, category, etc., while entering name on OMR sheet, leave one box between name and surname. Do not put any stray marks anywhere on OMR sheet, as it may lead to disqualification.
- Fill your name and roll no. on question paper also. Do not do any rough work or markings on question paper.
- For marking the answers darken the circle completely with **black/blue ball point pen** only. The correct and incorrect method of marking is shown on OMR sheet also.
- After completing the paper, leave question paper and answer sheet on your desk. **DO NOT** carry the question paper and answer sheet along with you.
- All the eligible candidates will report **30 minutes before commencement of the exam** on the scheduled date and time of exam in the respective Examination Hall / Lecture Theatre as per his/her Roll Number in the Seating Plan uploaded on the hospital's website.
- Result of written examination will be uploaded on the hospital's website.
- It is further reiterated that selected candidates will not be allowed to join without production of registration with Delhi Medical Council with MBBS & PG qualification.
- **OBC candidates should produce OBC certificate issued on or after 01.04.2020 in the prescribed format for Central Government job as per DOPT O.M. No. 36036/2/2013-Estt.(Res.) dated 30.05.2014.**
- **EWS candidates should produce EWS certificate issued by the competent authority in the prescribed format for Central Government job as per DOPT O.M. No. 36039/1/2019-Estt.(Res.) dated 31.01.2019.**
