**Subject: Implementation of Suo-Motu disclosure under Section 4 1(b) of RTI Act, 2005. Issue of guidelines-reg.**

Sir,

With reference to the letter No. SJH/AA/RTI-2022 dated 17.01.2022 on the subject cited above, the information is given below:

**Services offered by the department-**

Medico-legal postmortem is conducted after the concerned Investigating Officer (Police or Magistrate) submits the inquest papers with request to conduct the postmortem in the department of Forensic Medicine. After conduct of postmortem the body is handed over to the relatives through the I.O. and report is submitted by the doctor in the department record section. The Investigating Officer collects the report in original from the department.

Bone Age Estimation is conducted by a duly constituted medical board, in cases referred from the court or as per the law. The Age Report is submitted after completing the final opinion in the department record section. The same is collected by the concerned Investigating Officer.

The medicolegal reports including Post Mortem Reports and Age Estimation Reports are not handed over to the relatives. The relatives can approach the concerned Police Investigating Officer for the same.

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
