Instruction to Candidates for Written Examination.

1. All the Shortlisted Candidates should check his/her roll no. (Mentioned above) and must bring copy of the Admit Card to be printed (As per his/her roll no.) from the hospital website www.vmmc-sjh.nic.in.
2. No Candidate will be allowed to sit for Written Exam without Admit Card.
3. Carry one ID proof for the Written Exam (Aadhar card, Voter Card, Driving license, Pan Card).
4. **CANDIDATES SHOULD BE SEATED IN EXAMINATION HALL 30 MIN BEFORE STARTING OF EXAMINATION**
5. Result of written examination will be uploaded on hospital's website.
6. Candidates to bring **Black ball point pen.**
7. Textual material, printed or written, bits of papers, envelope or any other material likely Calculators, Electronic Digital Watches with facilities of calculators, cellular phones, pagers, Bluetooth devices or any other electronic gadget are **not allowed** inside the Examination hall.
8. Candidates are advised in their own interest not to bring any of the banned items including Mobile Phone to the venue of the examination as arrangement for safe keeping cannot be assured.
9. Any candidate found using any unfair means or cheating will be summarily disqualified from appearing in examination.
10. There are 100 MCQ questions to be answered **in one hour**. Each question has four options, out of which only one is correct/most appropriate.
11. **Negative Marking of one fourth (1/4) will be treated.**
